- Revise improvement strategies and expenditures.
- Recommend the approved single plan for student achievement (SPSA) to the governing board.
- Monitor implementation of the SPSA.

The West School Site Council meets one Monday each month during the school year (except January) at 3:15pm in the West library. Meeting dates are listed on the district calendar at the beginning of the school year. Regular attendance is crucial. Parent members commit to serving two consecutive years.
